Members of the public wishing to speak during Public Forum will be limited to a statement of no more than two (2) minutes in length. The Board will review statements and take action if necessary.

DISCLAIMER TO BE READ IN MEETINGS:

Public Form is an opportunity for the public to make statements to the Nanuet Public Library Board of Trustees. Statements are not made to other members of the public. The Board does not routinely comment on personnel issues in public. It is the Board's strong recommendation that any criticisms or compliments concerning personnel be made in writing and not presented at the open forum. Comments made in writing allow the Board to review the comments in detail and to ask the Director to review the comments and take action if necessary.

If no members of the public are present, the Disclaimer will not be read.
