

POLICY ON USE OF THE CHILDREN'S ROOM

The Children's Room of the Nanuet Public Library is hereby dedicated to the exclusive use of library patrons who fall within the following categories only:

1. Patrons of the library who are either age fourteen (14) or under the age of fourteen (14) years;
2. Patrons of the library who are over the age of fourteen (14) years and are accompanying a child under the age of fourteen (14) years who is utilizing library materials located in the Children's Room and
3. Adults and students who are using materials located only in the Children's Room.

It is the further policy of the Nanuet Public Library that any individual who does not fall within the above designated categories may not be allowed to use the Children's Room and may be requested and required to leave the Children's Room.
